This year, HOME of VA has submitted four public comments to the US Department of Housing and Urban Development regarding proposed changes to rules and regulations.

In each case — including proposals involving disparate impact, equal access, housing vouchers, and families with mixed immigration status — HOME has argued that the proposals exceed HUD's statutory authority and conflict with the Fair Housing Act.
